- GCSS-Army is the U.S. Army's web-based logistics and financial management system.
- Designed to modernize and integrate the Army's logistics and finance operations.
- Provides a single, integrated system for managing supply, maintenance, property and tactical finance.

WHAT DOES GCSS-ARMY DO?

- **Supply Management:** Enables users to manage and track the flow of supplies and equipment.
- Maintenance Management: Allows users to track and manage maintenance activities on equipment.
- **Property Accountability:** Provides a centralized system for tracking and managing property assets.
- **Tactical Finance:** Enables users to manage financial transactions and track expenditures.
- Data Uniformity: Integrates data from various sources into a single, unified view.
