WHAT IS EBS-C?

EBS-C will provide sweeping improvements to Army business processes across the enterprise. Specifically, it will:

- Re-engineer business processes against commercial best practices to reduce customization and related costs
- Streamline the logistics supply chain across numerous classes of supply
- Serve as the Army's authoritative source for financials and auditability
- Provide a solution that can adapt to changing conditions at the speed of conflict.

5 Army ERPs become 1 System: EBS-Convergence will merge multiple ERPs into one system.




The merged system will host more than 200K unique users across multiple commands.
